- Minimum of three letters of recommendation:
 - 1) School official
 - 2) Church official
 - 3) Job or community service supervisor
 - 4) Elected official
- Resume including extracurricular, personal, volunteer activities & employment
- Provide a copy of high school transcripts or FACTS.org computer 2.5 GPA signed by both School Official and student.
- Copy of Official College Entrance Exams Scores.
- Brief paragraph telling why you want the scholarship and explain your life and education goals.
- Essay selection from one of our questions contained within the application.
- Winner will need to appear before the Republican Executive Committee to present your essay. Meetings are held the 3rd Monday of the month at The Gathering Table in Chiefland.
